

Sir :

Miss Carrie E. Weekley, my matron in charge of girls, has been offered the superintendency of the school in Ponce, Porto Rico where she formerly taught, at a salary of \$1200 per annum, but feels she would rather stay at Carlisle at much less. In view of all the facts and her willingness to remain with us, I would like to give her an increase of salary, and do this without increasing the total of salaries. One of the \$720 positions as teacher asked for this year I had intended for Mrs. Cook who expected to return to us because she was being thrown out at Riverside. I now request that the salary of Matron be raised to \$860 and that a teacher's salary at \$720 be reduced to \$660.
