



Colonel Pratt:

I wish to attend the Newport, Oregon, Indian Convention, Aug. 17--22, and after the Convention to take 20 days' vacation as per application blank. If you approve of this I will make out the blank in ink. The plan mapped out will bring me back to Carlisle about the 23rd of September, counting two days off at Genoa on the return trip. The days at Chemawa, Albuquerque, Riverside and Genoa I have counted as days on duty. I counted five days going and five returning, when I really take 13 or 14 including Sundays, on the way out, and probably 7 returning. My desire is to return via Union Pacific, Ogden, Genoa, etc. Before purchasing tickets we have to designate return route.
