

To The Honorable,  
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir :

For several years past we have had an extra teacher who could take those pupils who were behind in certain studies and bring them up , and who was available whenever sickness or other reason deprived us of a school-room head. I had thought we might dispense with that teacher this year, but find as soon as I return on further considering it that it was a mistake. Already in the new year we have had urgent need for a teacher to substitute in case of absence from sickness. I therefore respectfully request that I may be allowed an additional teacher at \$600 for the ensuing year, thus placing us on the same footing as we were last year.
