
To The Honorable,

Sir :

I have the honor to enclose herewith bills amounting to \$50.30 incurred in the treatment of Thomas Mayo, one of our boys who is spending the winter in the country, together with statement from Mr. O. J. Randall with whom he lives.

Thomas was taken suddenly ill with pneumonia and as he was too sick to be removed to the school it was necessary to provide for him at his country home. Our own physician could not be sent, as he is employed by contract to visit the school only, and moreover, he was at the time kept here by serious illness in the school. I therefore respectfully request authority to settle this indebtedness.
