

Sir :

I have the honor to state that a prosecution is pending in the United States Court of this district for selling intoxicants to one of the Indian boys of this school. In order that the case may be established, the court holds that it is necessary to set out the executive order or act of Congress establishing the institution and detailing Col. Pratt as its superintendent. I am not able to obtain this information here and respectfully request that if it is in your office, you quote me the act of Congress or executive order referred to, designating where the same is found in the Government documents.
