

Sir:-

During the current fiscal year I have received \$135319.20 from the U.S. Treasury for support of this school. The value of supplies received through the Indian Office per invoices is \$15286.43. The amount of the appropriation is \$158000.00. The value of articles manufactured at the school and shipped to various agencies and schools to date, to be credited to "Indian School, Carlisle, Pa., 1904" is about \$2000.00. This should leave a balance of about \$9394.37 in the treasury, less cost of stationery furnished this school during the year.

I have the honor to request that I be informed ^{promptly} of the exact balance now in the treasury to the credit of the appropriation for this school for the fiscal year 1904.
