

Sir:-

Referring to your letter dated April 15, 1904, marked "Finance 22455-1904, Auth.87422," authorizing me to publish an advertisement for labor and material for the erection of a cottage, and to enter into contract for the same, I have the honor to inform you that no bids were offered for the stone work of the foundation, all the good masons being busy. In making search for a mason I found Mr. John P. McCard who agreed to do the work at the rate of 75 cents per perch. It was important that the foundation should be promptly built in order that the other work on the building might not be delayed. I therefore employed Mr. McCard to build the foundation walls at an expense of \$103.50, as evidenced by the bill and voucher submitted herewith for approval.
