Dear Sir:

The President having approved of the detail of Capt. W. A. Mercer, 7th Cavalry, as Superintendent of the Carlisle Industrial School, to take effect July 1, 1904, you are hereby directed to notify Brig-Gen. R. H. Pratt, retired, that his services as Superintendent will not be required after June 30, 1904, and for him to turn over to his successor, Capt. W. A. Mercer, all the property belonging to the Government, and held by him as Superintendent, taking a receipt for the same.

Capt. Chalmers G. Hall having been designated by the President to succeed Captain Mercer as Acting Indian Agent at the Uintah and Ouray Agency, Utah, you will issue the necessary instructions to the latter to turn over the Agency and the property there to Captain Hall, in accordance with the regulations of your office and the Department.
