Sir:-

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of two Indian office circular letters dated July 1, 1904, marked "Accounts.41320-1904," amending the Regulations of the Indian Office, 1894, one directing that weigher's returns be attached to vouchers for payment for certain specified articles, and the other directing that when individual Indian moneys or miscellaneous receipts of any class are received during the period for which an account is rendered a schedule thereof must be attached to the account current showing as to each item the source from which received, the date and amount of receipt, and the object for which the money was paid in, and that such schedule must be supported by a certificate of the agent as to correctness.

The individual moneys of pupils of this school are comprised in part of funds sent direct to them by their parents, guardians and friends, of amounts due them from land or grass rents, annuities etc. The earnings of the pupils under the outing system, however, constitute the principal part of their individual moneys.

All moneys received here for pupils of this school, from whatever source, are credited to their individual accounts and kept separate from our Government funds.

Miscellaneous receipts of Government funds have been regularly accounted for and the information called for by this amendment have been shown in de-


