



Carlisle, Pa., September 8, 1904.

It is hereby agreed by and between Capt. W.A. Mercer, Supt. Indian Industrial School, Carlisle, Pa., party of the first part, and Dr. S.L. Biven, of Carlisle, Pa., party of the second part, that the said party of the second part, who has been rendering professional services for said Indian Industrial School to date during the current fiscal year, shall continue to do so for the remainder of the year, or until such earlier date as he may be superseded by a resident physician; that he shall visit the school daily, and more frequently when required, and shall receive salary at the rate of \$720.00 per annum in quarterly payments of \$180.00 each.

It is further agreed by and between both parties hereto that this agreement is revocable upon notice of fifteen days from either party or from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
