Sir:

Referring to Office letter "Education 69924-1904" relative to the appointment of an Indian named "Patrick" Kennedy, now enrolled as a pupil at this school, to the position of fireman, to take the place of Charles W. Yeager, temporarily employed, I have to state that it is not for certain reasons deemed to be practicable or advisable to submit definite recommendation at this time as to this appointment, to take effect at a specified time.

It should be explained here that the correct name of the Indian proposed to be appointed to this position is Charles Kennedy instead of Patrick. There are two students enrolled here under respective given names indicated, and in my former letter their names were inadvertently confused.

The appointment of Charles Kennedy has been fully determined, and recommendation will be submitted within a short time. Meanwhile I respectfully request that the matter be allowed to rest as at present.
