Sir:

Referring to your letter of the 29th instant, relative to the employment of Charles Kennedy vice Charles W. Yeager now employed temporarily as fireman at this school, in which you indicate that it will not be possible to retain Mr. Yeager longer in this position, and that if Kennedy can be placed at work within a week or ten days it will be satisfactory, I have to state that it had been deemed impracticable to have Mr. Kennedy assume the duties of the position for several weeks yet. Matters have been arranged, however, so as to have Kennedy begin work on November 8th next.

His appointment will be duly submitted when Kennedy begins work as above indicated.
