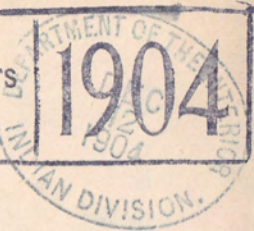

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I have the honor to request that authority be granted to employ a steam fitter for the period of thirty days at not to exceed \$3.00 per day. In connection with this request I have to state that the steam heating plant at this school, which is quite extensive, is in great need of repairs; that some steam fitting is also required to be done at the new double cottage nearing completion; and that the engineer at this school has been prevented from giving the necessary attention to this work owing to his employment in connection with the installation of the new stokers, contracted for by my predecessor.
