The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I have the honor to transmit herewith the request of Minnie L. Ferree, Assistant Matron at this school, dated the 5th instant, asking permission to call at the Indian Office at an early date for the purpose of conferring about her proposed transfer to another school, and in connection therewith attention is invited to my letter of the 1st instant transmitting Miss Ferree's request for such transfer.

In connection with this request for permission to visit the Indian Office I have to state that Miss Ferree has six days annual leave now due her which has heretofore been granted, and if the Office is willing to have her visit Washington for the purpose indicated I have no objection to her request being granted.

It appears that Miss Ferree has an opportunity to secure a position outside the Government service, although she prefers to remain in the Indian Service, and that it is necessary for her to know what she may expect at an early date in order that she may make her plans accordingly.
