To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I am in receipt of the Acting Commissioner's letter dated the 10th instant inclosing one dated the 5th instant from Miss Laura Taylor asking that she be reinstated as an assistant seamstress in the Indian school service and that she be given a position as soon as possible. You refer her letter to me for recommendation.

In reply I have to state that Miss Taylor has been here for several weeks but that she left on the 12th instant for Washington, D.C., where she has secured a position to do household work. It is therefore assumed that she would not care to receive an appointment as assistant seamstress at this time. So far as I am advised as to her capability she is qualified to fill the position she asks for. As to whether or not she should be reinstated, however, it is suggested that you might consult her wishes further. Her address is 1430 Stoughton St., N.W., Washington, D.C. Miss Taylor's letter is herewith returned.
