

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

Referring to the resignation of Oliver Harlan, assistant farmer at this school, and the acceptance of the same by the Indian Office to take effect December 31st, I have to state that arrangements have been made with Mr. Harlan to continue in charge of the farm occupied by him until his successor is appointed and reports for duty. This employment is absolutely necessary as there is considerable stock at the farm in question, and the buildings and other property there require the presence of someone to look after the same. With your approval, Mr. Harlan will be paid the salary previously received by him for such additional time as he may continue in the service.
