To the Honorable,


The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I inclose herewith a letter from the Superintendent of Industries at this school in which he recommends the appointment of an assistant blacksmith, the same being made necessary to secure closer supervision and greater individual instruction of the increased number of apprentices in that department. I concur in this recommendation.

I desire to appoint Charles Dillon, an Indian who has just finished his course at the school and who is able to render efficient service as assistant blacksmith, and I recommend that the position of assistant blacksmith at \$35.00 per month be authorized at this school, to date from January 16, 1905.
