You are, therefore, directed to have the physician under your charge fill up as briefly as possible the report, giving, in a separate accompanying report fuller details, if deemed necessary. The diseases indicated in the blank are those which largely affect the growth, progress, and efficiency of a race, and, therefore, such data, especially when related to the Indian who has been in school, and who has not, should be prominently brought forward. The general effect of these diseases on the advancement or retrogression of the tribe should be discussed. You will notice that the blank does not call for names, as general results are desired. Please have physician fill out and return as soon as possible.
