
To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

In reply to your communication of January 19th (Education), referring to the vacancy in the position of Superintendent of Printing at this school and desiring prompt information as to what are my wishes in regard to the matter, I have to say that the printing department is being conducted very efficiently by the Indian assistant and with the general supervision of the Superintendent of Industries, and that the work is being done better than it has ever been done since I have been at the school and I have concluded it is better not to have a new man sent in; and therefore I recommend that the position of Superintendent of Printing at \$1000 be abolished.
