To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

Referring to the vacancy in the position of assistant matron at this school at \$600 per annum, I have to state that I am in receipt of a letter from Florence N. Head, at present in the Indian School Service, located at Hayward, Wisconsin, indicating that she would be willing to accept a transfer to this school and to the position indicated. It appears, however, that Mrs. Head has a son, and as it would be necessary for her to be quartered in the girls' dormitory it would be out of the question to have the son with her on the school grounds. She indicates that she could secure a place for him in town.

It is respectfully requested that steps be taken to effect the transfer of Mrs. Head to the position of assistant matron at this school upon the condition and with the understanding that provision must be made for the accommodation of her son outside the school grounds. It is desired that this transfer should be effected with as little delay as possible.
