Dear Sir!

If the newspapers of this morning are correct in stating, that your idea of having the Indian boys taught in the military drills and dutys of a soldier, I would like to ask your kindness to consider this letter a application for a position at the institution at Carlisle (Pa). I served as a soldier in the 5th U.S. Cavalry for the full term of 5 years and was hon: discharged therefrom. I served as baker, butcher & cook in different places daily associating with Sioux Indians, at Fort Niobara, Neb: and Fort Reno Ind: Terr: where I was discharged. I enlisted as a baker served about 1 1/2 year as baker and during my enlistment done all the killing there was to be done I have also worked here for the Rodden Packing Co: then I spendet most of my time of service in the kitchen. And I believe myself thoroughly capable in teaching does branches. At the last years ^{Army} manuevers at West Point, Kentucky I served as a cook for Co: E 1st Regt: W. N. Guard and received the highest points in all points. I was recogniced as a ~~ex~~ Soldier by the inspecting Col: by the good order & management of the kitchen and was the only one

that could show a saving in rations and others where short. I am now married but desire very much to leave this city as it is too close to the lake and therefore the climate not becoming to me. Enclose please find my Reg: Army Discharge also from the Wis. Nat: Guard. Hoping I will soon hear from you
