The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

Replying to your office letter (Education) dated the 9th instant stating that there is a vacancy in the position of assistant engineer at the Pine Ridge Agency boarding school, South Dakota, at \$540 per annum, and inquiring whether I can recommend a competent young Indian man for the position, I have to state that from such information as I have been able to secure any one of the following young men, former students at this school, can be recommended as being capable of filling the position:
