To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I am in receipt of your office letter (Education, Authority 92546), dated the 9th instant, approving my recommendation for the abolishment of certain positions at this school including "two of the positions of assistant seamstress at \$300 per annum, to take effect January 24, 1905." In this connection attention is respectfully invited to my letter of the 23d ultimo and to your office reply thereto, dated the 28th ultimo (Education 6469-1905) authorizing me to promote Miss Margaret O. Eckert, seamstress, to the position of assistant matron, to take effect January 24th; also authorizing me to submit the relief of Mary E. Lininger, seamstress, to take effect January 31, 1905.

It is suggested, therefore, that your office letter of the 9th instant granting authority for the abolishment of two positions of assistant seamstress on January 24th is an error. Mrs. Lininger served up to and including the 31st ultimo and was paid her salary accordingly. It is suggested that this apparent discrepancy be rectified by suitable letter.
