
To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I transmit herewith the resignation, dated the 11th instant, of Johnson Bradley as fireman at this school at the salary of \$420 per annum. I have to recommend that the resignation be accepted as tendered to take effect on the 11th instant.

Authority is requested to employ a fireman temporarily in this position at the salary named, \$35 per month. It is not deemed necessary to fill this position permanently at the present time as it will only be necessary to have the services of such fireman for six or eight weeks longer, after which time the two firemen will be able to perform the required duties in the heating plant until next October.
