To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:


I am in receipt of your office letter, Education 20150--1905, dated the 17th instant relative to the employment of a teacher temporarily at the regular authorized salary of \$660 per annum to take the place of Miss Florence M. Carter, deceased.

In reply I have to state that Mr. Frank B. Green has been employed to fill the place of Miss Carter since and including the 13th instant. As indicated in my former letter I have agreed to pay him \$50 per month while temporarily employed, which amount is entirely satisfactory to him. I feel that it would be an injustice to our old teachers who are now receiving but \$50 per month and who are doing efficient and satisfactory work to pay an inexperienced teacher \$55 per month, even temporarily. The welfare of our school, I think, justifies the recommendation that one of our old teachers be promoted to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Miss Carter and that the temporary appointee be employed to fill the position vacated by such promotion.

I have therefore to recommend that Mrs. Emma H. Foster, who is now receiving \$600 per annum as teacher, be promoted to the position of teacher at \$660 per annum, now vacant, the same to be

effective from March 13th. I, at the same time, submit the temporary appointment of Mr. Frank B. Green to fill the position of teacher at the salary of \$600 per annum for the period of not exceeding two months, beginning March 13th.
