
Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your circular letter marked "Accounts" dated March 29, 1905, in which agents and superintendents are directed "to pay hereafter all duly authorized Indian Irregular Employees the several sums due them at the close of each week, taking their receipts therefor in the usual manner."


Inasmuch as no Indians are employed irregularly at this school, except during the vacation months, when the largest pupils remaining here receive small amounts for their services, it does not appear that the circular referred to should apply to this school. The pupils draw money regularly from their personal accounts for their own use.
