

To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

It is my duty to report to you the death here in the school hospital of another of our girls, Ellen Macey, from tuberculosis. Her death occurred on the 1st instant, a little less than two months after she was admitted to the hospital and after the disease manifested itself. The case was therefore an unusual one in the rapidity of the decline of the patient. The deceased was a member of the Umpqua tribe and came here from her home at Gardiner, Oregon in October, 1903.
