
To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

I have the honor to recommend that the salary of Miss Margaret O. Eckert, appointed sometime ago as an assistant matron at this school at \$40 per month, be increased to \$50 per month or \$600 per annum, the same to take effect from April 1st. There are now employed but two matrons in the girls' quarters, to which Miss Eckert has been assigned, instead of three as formerly. These two are now receiving a total salary of \$1200 per annum (\$720 and \$480) whereas last year the three matrons received a total salary of \$2100. The work under the present arrangement is very arduous and taxing and the increase of salary recommended for Miss Eckert is earned and deserved, and I trust that you will see your way clear to allow the increase at this time instead of waiting until the beginning of the next fiscal year. The work of Miss Eckert as assistant matron is satisfactory in every way.
