To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Replying to the closing paragraph of the Acting Commissioner's letter "Education 26358-1905," dated the 10th instant, I have to state that I think it would be advisable to transfer Mrs. Florence N. Head to the position of seamstress in some other school as soon as opportunity offers, and I respectfully recommend that this be done. In making this recommendation I do not wish to be understood as expressing an opinion as to Mrs. Head's qualifications for the position of seamstress, as she has not been employed in this capacity here long enough to enable me to express an opinion. The superintendent of the Hayward Indian school, however, at the time of Mrs. Head's transfer, spoke very highly of her as an employee, and as she was employed in that school as seamstress his commendation had reference of course to her work as such.
