

Sir:

In reply to your letter of June 2d, "Education 41409" I have to say that Harry K. Cole, son of Princess Chinquilla, entered the school at 14 years of age in December, 1899, pursued no industrial course, and deserted in March 1902, so that he was here but little over two years, and of course under the above conditions we are unable to recommend him for any position in the Indian service.
