
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

We have had three or four letters lately, of which those inclosed herewith are samples, regarding an alleged payment of \$100 each to members of the Seneca Nation of Indians under a so-called Kansas award. We have written to U.S. Indian Agent B.B. Weber of the New York Agency in reference to the matter and he states that he knows nothing about it other than what is stated in the printed slip herewith. In order that we may be able to take intelligent action and give proper advice to several of our students who claim to be interested I wish you would advise us fully in regard to this matter, stating the nature of the claim, to whom, where and how the payments are to be made.
