
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

Referring to my descriptive statement of changes of school employees at this school, submitted this date, I desire to invite your attention to my letter of May 29, 1905, in which I recommended for transfer, for reasons stated, a number of the employees whose nominations are submitted on the descriptive statement mentioned above. I respectfully invite your attention to my recommendations in this connection, which I repeat with the added request that the position of sloyd teacher be abolished upon the expiration of the leave of absence granted miss Stewart, July 31, 1905.

There are a number of positions authorized which are vacant, as follows: Boys' Field Agent, Carriagemaker, Teacher at \$600, and Assistant Cook. For these positions I desire to make recommendations and request that they be not filled without reference to me. As for two of them, I have already made selections, subject to your approval, and names will be reported in a few days.
