
Sir:

In reply to your communication, "Education 54211-1905", dated the 15th instant, I have to inform you that under date of July 13th I wrote to Miss Anne H. Stewart, at Chicago, Ill., quoting your Office letter of the 12th instant offering her a transfer as teacher at the Fort Lapwai school, and asked that she wire me whether or not she would accept said transfer. I also informed her that I had recommended the abolishment of the position of sloyd teacher at this school to take effect July 31st. I am now in receipt of the following telegram from Miss Stewart declining the transfer:

"Cannot accept transfer to position offered but respectfully request to be retained in the service."

In compliance with your instructions of the 15th instant I have this day informed Miss Stewart of the abolishment of the position of sloyd teacher at this school to take effect July 31st.
