The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,



Sir:

Replying to letter of the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, dated the 17th instant, "Education 42383-1905", I have the honor to recommend that, with the exception of two female teachers with some normal training, all vacancies in the teachers corps that now exist or that may be caused by transfers in connection with my recommendation of May 29th be filled by male teachers, and that both male and female be selected from the eligible list of the Civil Service Commission.

Any vacancies that may occur hereafter I shall make special recommendations about, but those covered by my recommendations up to this date, I desire shall be filled as above.
