
To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

In accordance with my recommendations your Office abolished the positions of three assistant laundresses. Two of these positions were abandoned last fiscal year and one commencing with the present fiscal year. Additional experience and knowledge of conditions as they exist at the laundry lead me to acknowledge that the recommendation for the abolishment of the last or third position of assistant laundress was a mistake and not in the direct line of economy.

I have therefore to request that the position of assistant laundress at \$300 per annum be authorized, and that I be permitted, temporarily, in the meantime, to employ, the former incumbent or some other suitable person.
