Sir:

Under recent date the superintendent of industries at this school reports as follows:


"In order that closer supervision and more individual instruction may be given apprentices in the coachmaking department, I recommend the appointment of an assistant coachmaker.

I recommend the appointment of Wilson Charles, a Carlisle graduate of 1905, and one of the best coachmakers we have ever graduated."

It is my intention to pay more attention to the department of carriage and wagon making than it has been given in the past few years. We have a prospect of many orders. An assistant carriage-maker is, in my opinion, necessary, and I recommend that the position of assistant carriagemaker at \$420 per annum be authorized from September 1, 1905.

If the position is authorized I desire to appoint one of our recent graduates, who is a very fine workman.
