The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,



Sir:

In M. I. Zeigler, the school has a most excellent harness maker and instructor in that line. He can command much higher wages and feels that he should receive more than he is now getting at the school. I was satisfied that he should have an increase in salary and recommended an increase of \$5.00 per month commencing the present year, which makes his salary \$55 per month, but that is not satisfactory to him and I think he should have a little more, and hereby recommend that the salary of harnessmaker at this school be increased to \$720 per annum.

Mr. Zeigler is the expert whom you called upon to assist in awarding the contracts in leather, harness, etc., at the opening of bids in Chicago.
