I forward herewith letter from Miss Mollie V. Gaither, who applies for the position of assistant superintendent at Umatilla. Miss Gaither's work here as girls' outing agent has been and is satisfactory, but she has not been fully satisfied inasmuch as her heart is at Umatilla, to which place she very much desires to be returned. I believe that she is able to do effective work as assistant superintendent there, or as superintendent of any of the smaller schools, whereas she lacks knowledge of the individual girls here, which can only come from long experience at the school, in order to make her service most effective in her present position.

I recommend that if practicable her application be granted.
