INDIAN INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL.

Carlisle, Pa., August 26, 1905.

Dear Sir, Unless there is now a place where I can be transferred as seamstress I respectfully resign my position as matron at the Carlisle Indian school, such resignation to take effect September 1, 1905, retaining the privilege of being reinstated some time within the year as seamstress or matron.

Respectfully forwarded, recommending that unless she can be transferred at once as seamstress, as requested, that the resignation of Frances A. Veitch be accepted to take effect September 1, 1905, as tendered.

I further recommend that she be not reinstated at this school as matron, as while she may be competent to render efficient service at a smaller school, I do not think that she can give satisfactory service here where there are so many large girls.
