It is agreed between the sender of the message written on the face hereof and the Postal Telegraph-Cable Company, that said Company shall not be liable for mistakes or delays in the transmission or delivery, or for non-delivery of any UNREPEATED message, beyond the amount received for sending the same; nor for mistakes or delays in the transmission or delivery, or for non-delivery of any REPEATED message beyond fifty times the sum received for sending the same, unless specially insured for in any case for delays arising from any such interruption in the working of its lines, or for errors in cipher or obscure messages. And this receipt hereby made the agent of the sender, without liability to forward any message over the lines of any other company when necessary to reach its destination.

Business in the transmission of messages to any point by the Company can be insured by contract in writing, stating agreed amount of risk, and payment of premium hereon, at the following rates, to be added to the usual charge for repeated messages, viz: one penny for any distance not exceeding 1,000 miles, and two per cent. for any greater distance.

No responsibility regarding messages attaches to this Company until the same are presented and accepted at one of its transmitting offices; and if a message sent touch one by any of this Company's messengers, he is for that purpose as the agent of the sender.

Messages will be delivered free within the established free delivery limits of the terminating office. For delivery at a greater distance a special charge will be made by the Company to cover the expense of delivery.

This company will not be held responsible for damages or liability for parties in any case where the claim is not presented in writing within six days, and the message is not within the Company's transmission.

Messages are not guaranteed unless they are delivered by request of the sender under the conditions named above. Messages can be guaranteed against loss by retaining a message blank to the sending station for comparison. No charge of this Company authorized to vary the foregoing.
