
Sir:

There is a great deal of work and responsibility connected with it, and it takes an exceptionally good woman with great force of character to handle it. In the temporary appointment of Mrs. Evalyn MacKey I think I have found the proper person.

Mrs. MacKey was formerly matron of the Uintah and Ouray schools, and I believe has had other experiences. I should very much like to have her permanently appointed and I have to request that, if possible under the rules, she be given a non-competitive examination.
