
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir:

Referring to your letter, Education 75778 - 1905, I recommend that Mr. Fred W. Canfield, Drawing Teacher at this school, be transferred to the position of Boys' Outing Agent here. Mr Canfield has had some experience in performing the duties of this position temporarily at different periods and in other respects is, in my opinion, very well qualified for the position.

In case Mr. Fred W. Canfield is transferred from the position of Drawing Teacher to that of Outing Agent I request that another Drawing Teacher be selected from the Civil Service list and appointed for duty here and that before selection is made I be notified, so that either myself or my assistant may examine the papers of the candidate with a view to making selection of the person that will be best fitted in every respect to meet the needs of the children and the requirements and conditions of this school.
