
Sir:

I transmit herewith the resignation of the farmer at this school, Mr. Benjamin F. Bennett, to take effect November 6th.

I respectfully recommend that the resignation be accepted as tendered and that Mr. Norman H. Justus be promoted from the position of assistant farmer to the position of farmer, vice Mr. Bennett. Mr. Justus has done good work since his arrival here and is entitled to the promotion from \$600 to \$720 per annum.

I have also to request that steps be taken at once to fill the position of assistant farmer by transfer or appointment through the Civil Service Commission. The appointee should be a married man, preferably without children. Please secure for us the best man possible as the position is an important one to the welfare of the school.
