To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

By letter dated the 13th ultimo the Auditor of the Treasury for the Interior Department advised this school that a claim in its favor for \$94 had been settled in the Auditor's office and allowed on June 30th, and that payment thereof would be made by crediting the appropriation "Indian School Carlisle, Pa., 1905."

This claim was for a surrey furnished the Grand Junction, Colorado, Indian school on June 30, 1905. The shipment was made too late to enable us to secure the funds for use during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1905, and as our appropriation is \$8,000 less for the present fiscal year than it was for the year 1905, and as the average enrollment and attendance of this school for the present year will perhaps be 150 or 200 pupils more than it was last year, it is respectfully requested that, if it can be arranged, the said \$94 be placed to the credit of the appropriation "Indian School, Carlisle, Pa., 1906." Please advise us of your action and whether requisition for this money can be made during the present fiscal year.
