
To the Honorable,

It is my painful duty to report the death, at one o'clock p.m., on yesterday the 17th instant, of John Quagin, aged 18, of the Chippewa tribe, a pupil at this school from Reserve, Wisconsin. The funeral services are to be held at 4 p.m. today and interment will be in the school cemetery. The death was caused by pneumonia which was contracted a short time ago. During the boy's illness his father was kept informed by mail and telegraph of his condition.
