Referring to our letter of Nov. 8th, and to Office letter in reply thereto dated Nov. 14th in reference to the transfer of Mr. Henry Vertreace, our blacksmith, to another position in the service where educational qualifications are not required, I wish to inquire when action may be expected in the matter.
