

Sir:

Referring to Office letter "Education 103355-05", dated the 29th ultimo, and correspondence previous thereto, with reference to the transfer of Miss Cloy Montgomery of the Sac and Fox School, Oklahoma, to the position of teacher at this school, you are advised that Miss Amelia McMichael has reported for duty and that it will not therefore be necessary to effect the transfer of Miss Montgomery.

There is still one of the positions of teacher vacant at this school at \$480 per annum, but it is thought that by employing temporarily for a few weeks longer we shall be able, with the assistance of our normal school assistants, to get along until our pupils go into the country for the spring outing, after which the present force of teachers will be able to handle the work.
