Referring to Office letter "Education 6080/1906", dated the 22d ultimo, by the Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, inquiring whether I can recommend Mary E. Lininger, of Carlisle, Pa., for reinstatement as seamstress at this school, I have to state that there is no vacancy at the school at the present time in the position of seamstress or assistant seamstress. She was formerly an assistant seamstress at the school and was dropped last year when a reduction was made in the number of assistant seamstresses. Her services were satisfactory and I can recommend her for a similar position in the Indian school service or as seamstress at a small school.
