

Sir:

I inclose herewith the resignation of Elizabeth Chenoweth Sloan, probationary appointee as assistant matron at this school, to take effect April 17, 1906, with the recommendation that the same be accepted.

Referring to my letter of March 10th in regard to the efficiency of Mrs. Sloan, I desire now to add to that that she has many good qualities and that if placed in charge as a matron at some smaller boarding school where she could have assistants or student girls to perform the heavier work she would get along very nicely as her experience at the head of a young ladies' school for a number of years should be of value to her in this position, but as I stated before she is not fitted for the position of assistant matron at a school like Carlisle. It is also my opinion, based on her experience, education and general refinement of character, that she would make a good teacher and probably a fairly good clerk, provided she has the necessary qualifications to pass the required examination.
