
Sir:

Authority is hereby requested to expend the sum of \$82 in payment of expenses incurred in the burial of Adelbert Williams, a student who contracted scarlet fever at the home of Mr. H. A. McComas, Philadelphia, Pa., and died at the Municipal Hospital in that city, as reported in my letter of the 10th instant.

I enclose herewith voucher showing items of expense, also sub-vouchers in support of same. Owing to the contagious nature of the disease which caused his death, the expense is somewhat larger than usually incurred in the burial of a pupil. I enclose herewith letter of Mr. McComas in explanation of the reasons for such expense, in addition will state that I believe that no unnecessary or avoidable or expenditure was made.
